
SIMSCON '22

Station 1: Preparation at birth


Station 2: Routine newborn care and initial steps of resuscitation

Station 4: Prolonged ventilation with chest compressions


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
The event was conducted successfully along with the distribution of participation certificate for each delegate.




Preparation for the Birth






The afternoon session started at 02:15PM. There was a session on **skills for effective doctor - patient communication** and few group activities were conducted regarding the topic.





Then at 3:30 pm, the training session was completed and feedback and posttest were conducted.



The participation certificates were distributed to the participants by the resource persons following the posttest.

Winner and Runner of the event were awarded with trophies and 30% gift voucher from Jaypee Publishers.



The coordinators did an excellent job in organizing and made this event successful.

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


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CAREER GUIDANCE COUNSELLING
