Initiatives taken by the Institution for promoting reforms

- ✦ *Engaging faculties in the reform process:* The faculties are involved in the process of designing and implementing innovative reforms. The curriculum committee members, HOD and teaching faculty are motivated to introduce reforms in the curriculum for the benefits of students.
- ✦ *Providing training and development opportunities:* The institution provides faculty development programs and certification in various fields like e-content development, Learning Management System (LMS) Moodle training, skill training sessions, active teaching learning strategies, entrepreneurship skills, innovative teaching learning, ethics, and sensitizing programs on Intellectual Property Rights.
- ✦ *Recognize and reward faculty contributions:* Recognition and rewards are given to faculty members who actively participate in promoting reforms and serve as resource persons for in house guest lectures/expert talks/webinars/seminars. Faculty attending national/international conferences are reimbursed with the registration fees.
- ✦ *Foster a culture of innovation:* The institution fosters a culture of innovation that encourages new experimentation in teaching learning strategies. The faculties are encouraged to come up with new ideas and experiment the various strategies by proper guidance with Medical Education Unit and field experts.
- ✦ *Fosters collaboration and communication:* Regular meetings, workshops, seminars and discussions among the departments are encouraged that facilitates better collaboration and communication to share ideas, best practices and challenges.
- ✦ *Institute Innovation Council (IIC):* As per the Ministry of Education, the institute has a functional IIC from 2021 onwards. The institute organizes various programs for leadership skills, field visits, expert talks, entrepreneurship skills, start ups and promotes innovation and creativity among faculty
- ✦ *Fosters Research and Development:* The institutional policies encourage faculty to do research and publish in indexed journals. The institution provides incentives for publication fees waived by the publishers. The research committee facilitates research in the unexplored and grey areas.

Outcomes of the innovative reforms

- ✦ *Accreditation:* The institution works with the vision of imparting holistic, evidence based medical education, quality patient care and ethical research has obtained National Accreditation Board for Hospitals (NABH) and National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL)
- ✦ *Fellowships and recognitions:* The faculties are certified in various national and international programs and fellowships like Advanced Course in Medical Education (ACME), Foundation for Advancement of International Medical Education and Research (FAIMER), and other fellowships in their respective subject

- ✦ *Student Support System:* The institution has an organized Student Support System, which plans for the mentor mentee meetings and parents' meetings. Apart from attendance and performance monitoring the system also provides support for students in the development of their overall mental and physical health. Regular review meetings are organized and based on the feedbacks obtained programs are organized for the student's welfare.
- ✦ *Outputs of IIC:* The Institutional faculties have obtained 40 design patents and 12 copyrights. The Institution Innovation Council has been graded 3.5 star rating by the Ministry of Education (MoE) for the academic year 2021-22. A total of 10 faculties have completed the Innovation Ambassador training program offered by the MoE.
- ✦ *Special training programs for students:* Remedial and tutorial classes are encouraged to facilitate the slow achievers. High achievers are motivated to participate in seminars, presentations, quizzes and other programs. The institution mandates its students to undertake field visits, clinical internships, research projects, industry visits and community postings. Regular case-presentations, seminars and journal club activities are conducted for post graduate teaching.
- ✦ *Projects and funding's obtained:* The faculty and students are motivated to take up Short Term Students-Indian Council of Medical Research (STS-ICMR) funded projects. The institution has signed MoU's with the other institutions for collaborative research projects.
- ✦ *LMS SMVMCH:* Resource materials in the form of e-books, PDFs, question banks, voice over PPTs, and other resources are made available for all students through LMS.
- ✦ *Publications:* The faculties have published their innovative teaching learning strategies as publications in various indexed journals.
- ✦ *Value added courses:* The institute also provides value added courses imparting transferable and life skills to the students. Also, inter-disciplinary and interdepartmental trainings are built within the programs.
- ✦ *Feedbacks:* Regular departmental meetings are conducted with the administrators to discuss about the teaching learning strategies, infrastructure, research and developments. Timely structured feedback is obtained from various stakeholders including the students, teachers and alumni and the suggestions are incorporated while updating the curriculum.
