Description of the report:

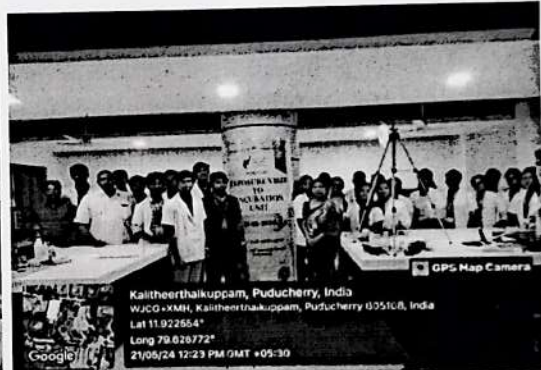
Exposure Vist :
