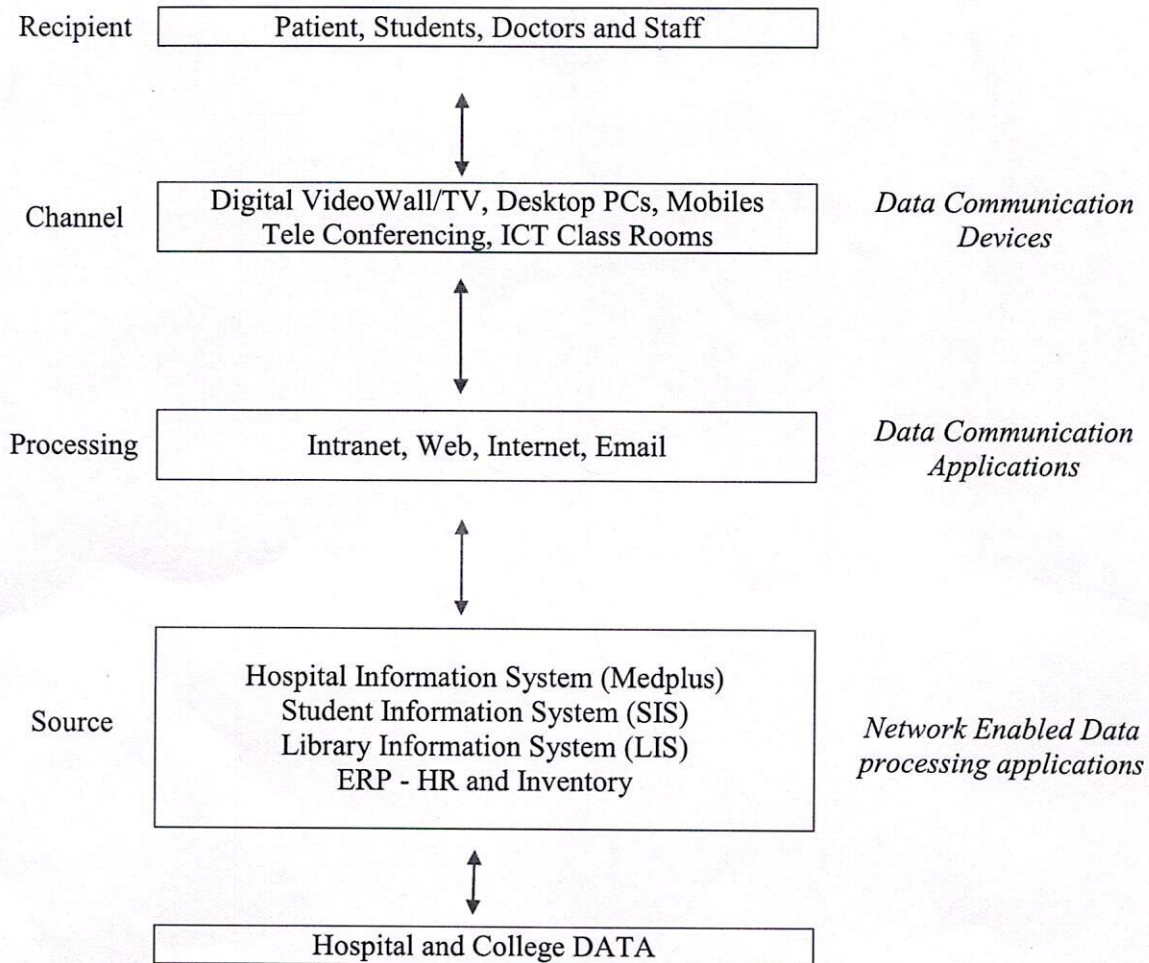
### **Features of e-governance system**

**Privacy vs. Safety**

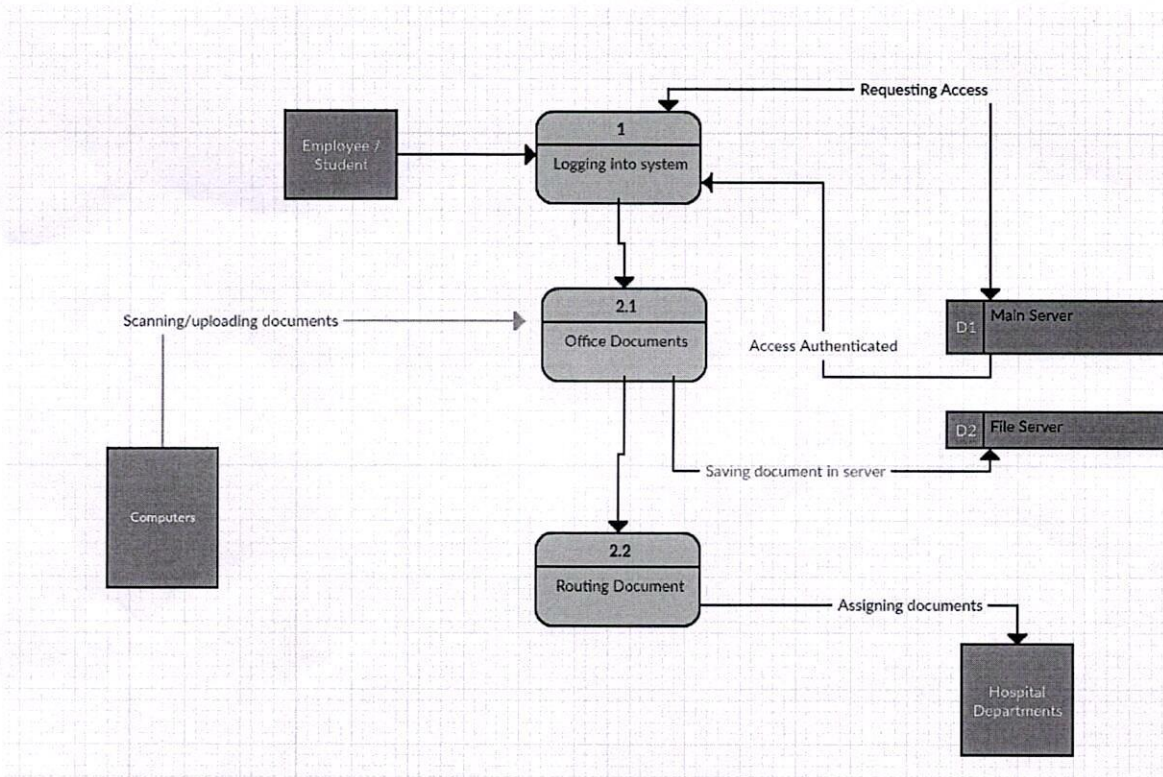
