Research at SMVMCH

SMVMCH continues to foster a thriving research culture among its faculty members by providing robust support for publishing articles, journals and book chapters. The institution offers incentives and covers 80% of publication fees, motivating faculty to excel in academic contributions. This year, over 100 publications have been successfully achieved, reflecting the college's commitment to advancing medical research. Additionally, SMVMCH boasts 33 functional MOUs and active collaborations with other institutions and alumni for research development.

The research committee and ethics committee play a crucial role in monitoring and ensuring the quality and innovation of all thesis and research articles. These initiatives underline the institution's dedication to enhancing academic standards and promoting groundbreaking research.

SMVMCH encourages undergraduate, postgraduate and faculty to pursue biomedical research to address and resolve health related issues. The students and faculty are eligible to apply for the intramural funding with appropriate justification in case of collaborative research. The organization provides research grant for selected projects based on relevance and quality of the proposed study. The submitted proposals will be reviewed by the research and ethical committee for the final approval.

Global Journal of Health Sciences and Research (GJHSR)

On behalf of our institution, we have launched a new in-house journal named Global Journal of Health Sciences and Research (GJHSR) in association with scientific scholar on 20th February 2023. It is an open-access peer-reviewed journal committed to publishing high-quality articles in the health related subjects. This is an international peer reviewed open access journal with the main aim of encouraging professionals to publish scientific, high quality contemporary literature to benefit the global scientific fraternity. The journal publishes original research articles, case reports and series, reviews, technical notes, images, clinicopathologic conferences and patent related articles. Its frequency of publication is semi-annual and publishes in both print and online formats.





Research facilities and resources at SMVMCH

Department of Integrative Medical Research (DIMR)

SMVMCH established Central Research Laboratory (CRL) in 2011 to provide centralized research infrastructure for the benefit of investigators across multiple disciplines at SMVMCH. CRL is now renamed as Department of Integrative Medical Research is located on the first floor of the college building. DIMR supports PG and UG students, faculties and PhD scholars, for their research activities by providing technical assistance and access to advanced scientific instruments. The research may be in the form of undergraduate research projects, postgraduate dissertation work, PhD thesis work and faculty research projects. In addition, DIMR organizes training programs, workshops/seminars and CME's for UG and PG medical students, research scholars and faculties in the focused areas of research.

DIMR support genetic studies holding facility for DNA, RNA and protein isolation and analysis. The labs possess the essential equipments, such as thermal cycler, electrophoresis units, ultra-centrifuge, water bath, spectrophotometer, multi-well plate reader and high performance liquid chromatography (HPLC). This could facilitates molecular biology research at DIMR for diagnostic purposes like dengue serotype identification, genotyping of scrub typhus pathogen, surveillance of hepatitis surface antigen, confirmation of genetic disorders such as prolidase deficiency, and cardiovascular diseases associated with gene polymorphisms and continue to support related works across various areas of medical research. Besides, the laboratory offers deep freezer facility for the long term storage of clinical samples like plasma, urine, breast milk, DNA, saliva, buffy coat, whole blood and tissue.

The public health laboratory had been initiated 5 years back. The major functions of the laboratory include water analysis, food sample testing for presence of adulteration and relative humidity measurement

Amphibian lab for animal studies

It has many instruments and facilities to do experiments to understand the nerve muscle physiology

Mammalian lab for animal studies

Various instruments, like Dale's apparatus, Langendroff apparatus, and Mariotte's bottle to carry out mammalian experiments are available

Research lab

An autonomic research lab is equipped with the following instruments to carry out research studies on humans

Heart rate variability (HRV): It is used to assess the sympathovagal balance in an individual at a given time, which reflects the cardiovascular functioning and risk stratification Evoked potential: Brainstem evoked potentials, visual evoked potentials and motor evoked potentials can be recorded measuring the electrical activities generated from the brain

Pulmonary function test: Computerized spirometry to evaluate the lung functions and disorders

ECG: Automated ECG with 12 leads

Nerve conduction study: To evaluate the conduction of electrical impulses along the nerve Body fat analyzer: It analyzes the body fat composition, BMI, skeletal and subcutaneous fat in the body based on bioelectrical impedance

EMG: Electromyography technique for recording and evaluating electrical activity in skeletal muscles


Treadmill: Computerized 12 lead treadmill for stress test to measure heart rate and blood pressure during exercise and recovery period


Road Map IIC Events 2024

Short course on Crafting Effective Mixed Methods in Health Research

The Department of Community Medicine (DCM) actively conducted short course on "Mixed Methods in Health Research" from 13th to 15th September 2023 at MEU hall. About 10 postgraduates and 9 faculties from various departments participated in the program. The course structure included introduction to Qualitative Research and various techniques, followed by demo and hands on session on Free list and Pile Sorting. The course also covered different types of Integration: Merging, Connecting, Building, Embedding, Logic model, Joint display Worksheet-6 in Mixed Methods Research followed by Feedback.



Workshop on Research Methods for First Year Postgraduates Training Workshop

The Research Committee members have organized a workshop on different research methods from 14th – 16th December 2023 at MIT auditorium. The workshop included the topics on Variables, Sample size, Sampling, Different study design and its limitation, Bias and ethical consideration and Illustration of data analysis with examples. About 70 postgraduates from various departments of SMVMCH participated in the workshop. They were engaged in hands-on sessions. The knowledge and experience gained will be helpful in their proposal writing and conducting study.

2nd Systematic Review and Meta-analysis Hands on Training Workshop

DCM in collaboration with Global Journal of Health Sciences and Research, SMVMCH conducted 4 days workshop on "Systematic Review and Meta-Analysis (SRMA)" on 14th and 21 to 23rd February 2024 at Own Book Reading Hall, SMVMCH. About 28 faculties and postgraduates from various departments of SMVMCH participated in the workshop. Dr. Jennifer Florence Mary, Assistant Professor, Department of Community Medicine, MGMC & RI and Dr. Reenaa Mohan, Assistant Professor, Department of Community Medicine, SMVMCH were the resource persons for the workshop. Faculties from various departments like Physiology, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Pharmacology, Community Medicine, Psychiatry, Orthopedics, Paediatrics, ICMR Scientists and Postgraduates from Department of Community Medicine participated in the workshop. Title selection, search strategy using PICOT, articles screening using Rayyan software, Data extraction, data analysis in Revman software and SRMA article drafting were elaborated in the workshop. Hands on training for articles searching in Pubmed, Google Scholar, Cochrane, and various check list for Risk of bias assessment were also taught in the program. The participants were divided into teams of two members and were encouraged to draft SRMA articles at the end of the session.





Workshop on Epi Info 7 software

DCM and the Research Committee, SMVMCH conducted a one-day workshop on Epi Info 7 software on 20th March 2024 at MIT auditorium for the final-year postgraduates. The interactive workshop provided a comprehensive introduction to biostatistics and the use of Epi Info for data analysis. Participants were engaged in hands-on sessions, enhancing their practical skills in creating data entry forms and performing statistical analyses. It was a successful event, equipping final-year postgraduates with essential skills to complete their thesis projects. The knowledge and experience gained will be invaluable in their future research prospects and professional career.





Workshop on Qualitative Research Methods

Department of Community Medicine has organized 3 days workshop on "Qualitative Research Methods" at Own Book Reading Hall from 23rd to 25th March 2024. About 33 faculties and postgraduates from various institutions participated in the workshop. Resource persons were Dr Kalaiselvan G, Professor, AIIMS Mangalgiri and Dr Mahalakshmi T, Additional Professor, JIPMER, Puducherry. The session was started with PRA techniques and experience sharing which included teamwork in the field. Second day started with a Recap session and Free listing and Pile sorting techniques were demonstrated to the participants and provided hands-on training. The participants were very interactive. On third-day interview techniques were elaborated.





Anthropometric Data Analysis Workshop

On behalf of DCM, SMVMCH, workshop on mastering Anthropometry Data Analysis was conducted on 5.7.2024 and 6.7.2024. About 17 members were participated in the session. On the first day, participants were introduced, and the fundamentals of Anthropometry including Z scores, Under nutrition indicators, and Growth charts, were discussed. This was followed by group activities on Growth chart calculations, Software installation for WHO Anthro survey analyzer, and Data preparation techniques. Afternoon sessions focused on Interpreting results, Group presentations, and Generating quality reports. The second day began with a recap and Installation of WHO Anthro Plus software, emphasizing Adolescent growth indicators. Participants were engaged in further Data preparation, Interpretation, and Public health applications of Anthropometry, including Literature review and Discussion of research articles. The workshop concluded with sessions on integrating anthropometric data with other software tools like SPSS, Jamovi and R and manuscript writing, followed by post-test, feedback, and certificate distribution.



Research Methodology – Topic: Manuscript Writing to Publication: Best Practices for Indexed Journals

The Department of DVL has organized a guest lecture on the topic "Manuscript Writing to Publication- Best Practices for Indexed Journals" as a part of Research Methodology on 24th May 2024 between 2:00 pm and 3:30 pm. Guest speaker of the event was Dr. S. Arun, Associate Professor, MGMC & RI, Puducherry. The event started with a brief introduction about the research methodology followed by an elaborative talk, which covered the basics and up to date aspects of writing a manuscript to publication by guest speaker. Around 110 Participants attended the guest lecture, which included faculties and postgraduates from other specialties. The session was moderated by Dr. K. Karthikeyan, HOD, Department of DVL, SMVMCH and Dr. P.Sanjay (Dean Research). An e-certificate of participation was generated.
