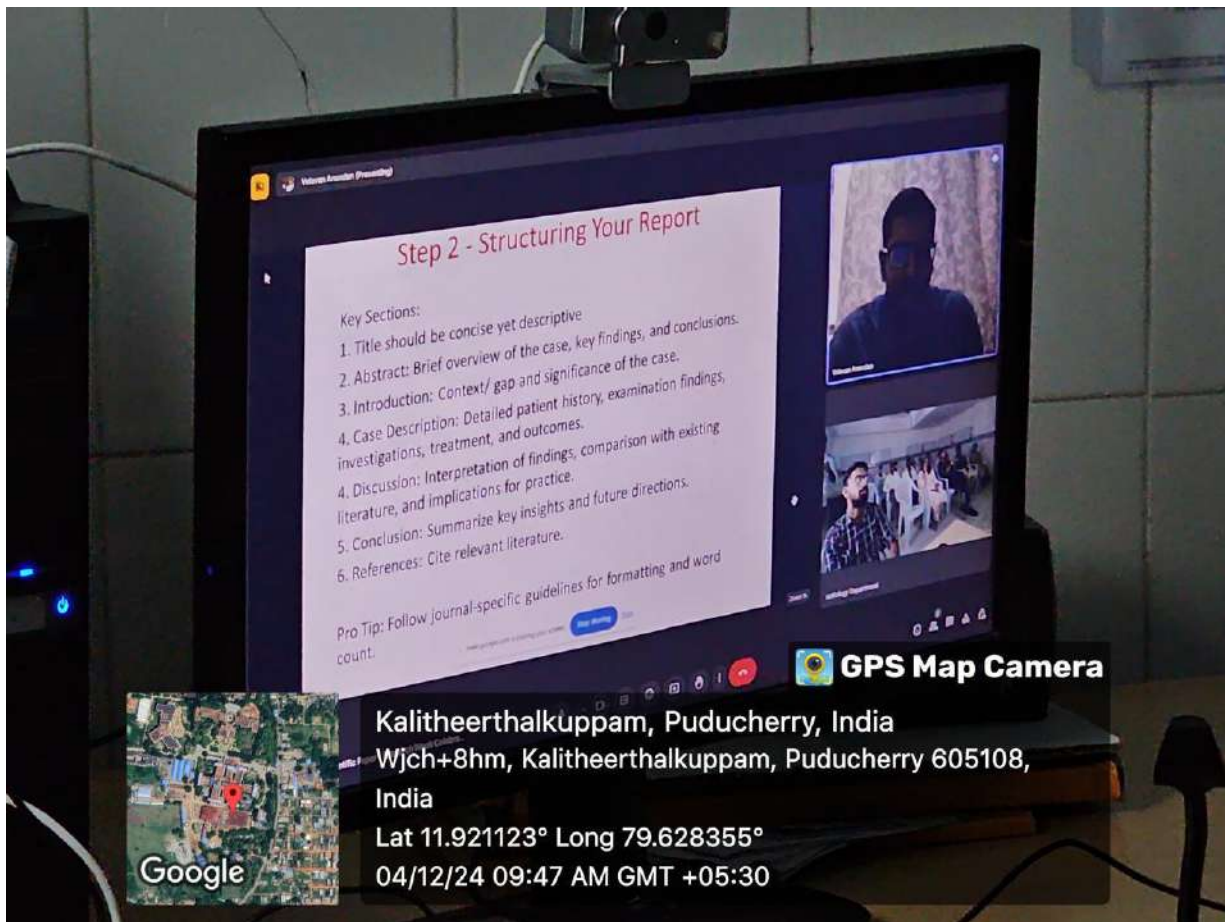
Outcomes: The participants are now aware of the various types of research activities.

Step 2 - Structuring Your Report

Key Sections:

1. Title should be concise yet descriptive
2. Abstract: Brief overview of the case, key findings, and conclusions.
3. Introduction: Context/ gap and significance of the case.
4. Case Description: Detailed patient history, examination findings, investigations, treatment, and outcomes.
4. Discussion: Interpretation of findings, comparison with existing literature, and implications for practice.
5. Conclusion: Summarize key insights and future directions.
6. References: Cite relevant literature.

Pro Tip: Follow journal-specific guidelines for formatting and word count.
