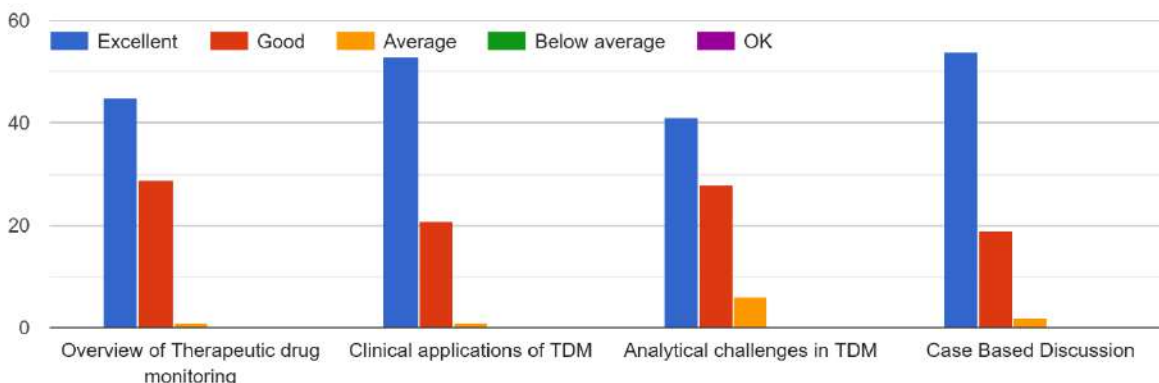


Programme Overview:

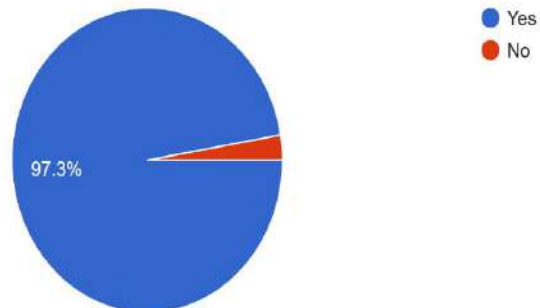

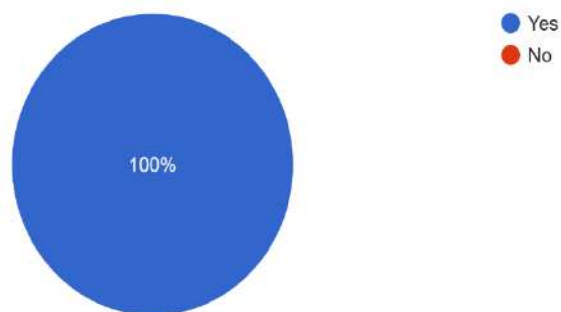
