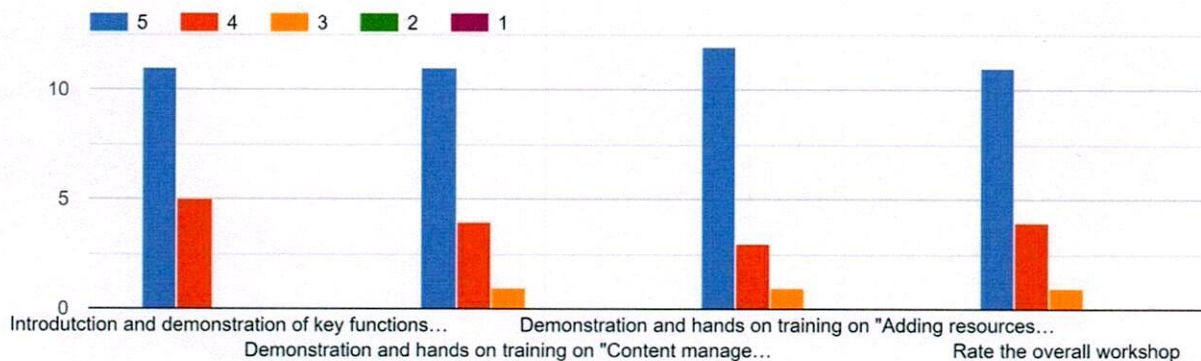
Report on E-training Programs

Workshop on "Learning Management System" (18.01.2022 to 21.01.2022)

Feedback Analysis



Workshop on "Digital Tools in Medical Education"

The MEU, organized a full-day workshop on "Digital tools in Medical Education" for the faculty of SMVMCH on rotation between 09.03.2022 to 11.03.2022. The program was organized to provide an overview, interactive and intense hands-on training on various digital tools that can be utilised for teaching, learning and assessment in Medical Education. The participants had a good experience in creating interactive e-content in the institutional LMS through the different ICT tools. Around 105 faculty participated in the program. The sessions were highly interactive and feedback has been obtained from all the participants

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Workshop on E-content and E-Course Development

The MEU, organized a full-day workshop on “E-Content and E-Course Development” for the faculty of SMVMCH on 21st December, 2022. The program was organized to provide an intensive hands-on training on the various ICT enabled tools that can be effectively utilized for effective teaching, learning and assessment. Around 28 faculty were oriented to the different ICT enabled tools and the multimedia principles. The participants enthusiastically participated in the hands-on training sessions on development of interactive images, creating animations, creating interactive PowerPoint presentations, conducting interactive online quizzes for large group. A session was exclusively dedicated for the participants to explore the institutional “Learning Management System”. An afternoon session was exclusively dedicated in sensitizing the participants towards “Instructional Design Models” involved in E-Course development and hands on experience was given on developing a template for E-course using MOODLE. The sessions were highly interactive and feedback has been obtained from all the participants. The mean pre and post test scores were 5.08 and 7 respectively. The workshop has been awarded 2 credit hours by the Tamil Nadu Medical Council.

Attempts were made to use ICT tools for various components of the workshop. The pre-test was conducted with google form, the post-test was conducted using “QUIZZIZ” platform, which was highly fun filled and enjoyed by the participants. Feedback was obtained from the participants in the platform called “PADLET”.

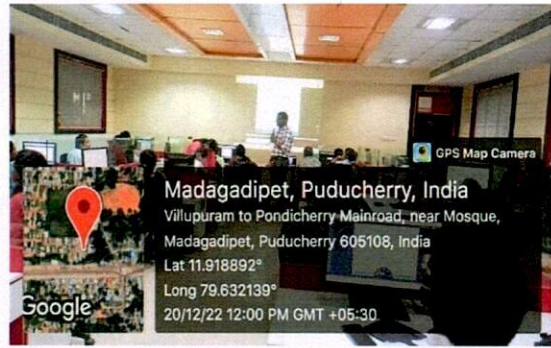

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Workshop on “E-Content and E-Course Development”

The MEU, organized a 2-day workshop on “E-Content and E-Course Development” for the faculty of SMVMCH on 25th & 26th October, 2021. The program was organized to provide an intensive hands-on training on the various ICT enabled tools that can be effectively utilized for effective teaching, learning and assessment. Around 30 faculty were oriented to the different ICT enabled tools and the multimedia principles. The participants enthusiastically participated in the hands-on training sessions on development of interactive images, creating animations, creating interactive PowerPoint presentations, essentials in opening a you tube channel and uploading contents into it, creating concept maps, conducting interactive online quizzes for large group, conducting interactive small group sessions with Nearpod, essentials of podcasting and screen recording. An afternoon session was exclusively dedicated in sensitizing the participants towards “Instructional Design Models” involved in E-Course development and hands on experience was given on developing a template for E-course. The sessions were highly interactive and feedback has been obtained from all the participants. The workshop has been awarded 4 credit hours by the Tamil Nadu Medical Council.

Feedback analysis

The mean pre-test score was 5.18 and the post test score was 7.92. The participants found the sessions interactive and appreciated the hands-on training offered for the ICT tools. However, they suggested the interruptions due to network connectivity may be avoided and demanded more time allotment for certain tools for effective hands-on training.

Outcome

- Development of interactive e-contents and sharing of the resources with the students

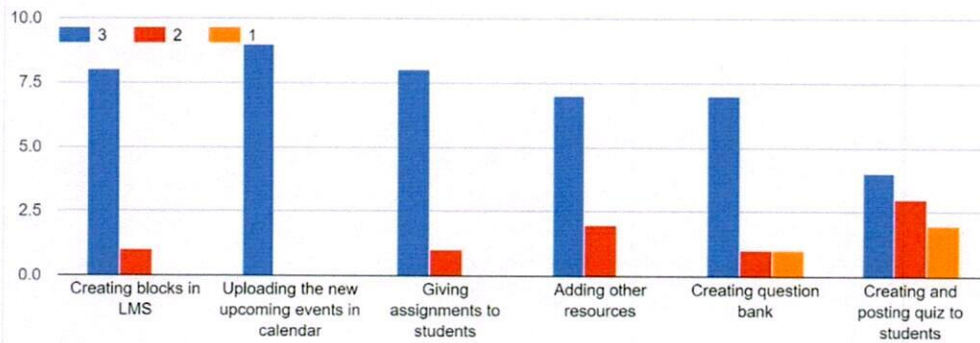


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Rate your confidence levels after LMS workshop 3-Confident; 2-No opinion; 1-Not confident

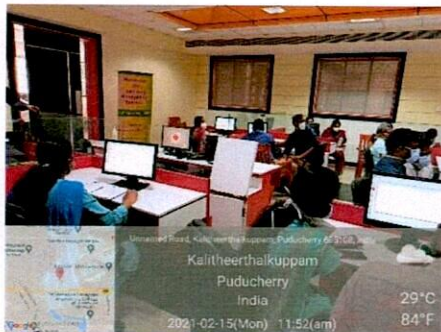


