1. Embracing Change:


 Participants recognized the need to embrace the changes proposed by the NEP for the holistic development of medical education.

 Participants expressed a willingness to adapt to the language policy changes, understanding the broader goals of inclusivity and accessibility.



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


Did you gain more knowledge on National Education Policy?




