Department of Paediatrics & IAP Villupuram and Puducherry Chapter, SMVCH commemorated the IAP Child and Health Care Week from November 13 to 19, 2019, in a grand manner.

Event 1: A mini exhibition on common adolescent health problems was inaugurated, educating around 120 nursing college students.

Event 2: Dr. Venkateswaran, an expert in child and adolescent psychiatry, delivered a guest lecture on "Adolescent Mental Health Problems and Parenting Challenges" to 150 medical college students and 50 faculty members. An interactive session addressed depression, anxiety, and curriculum management.
