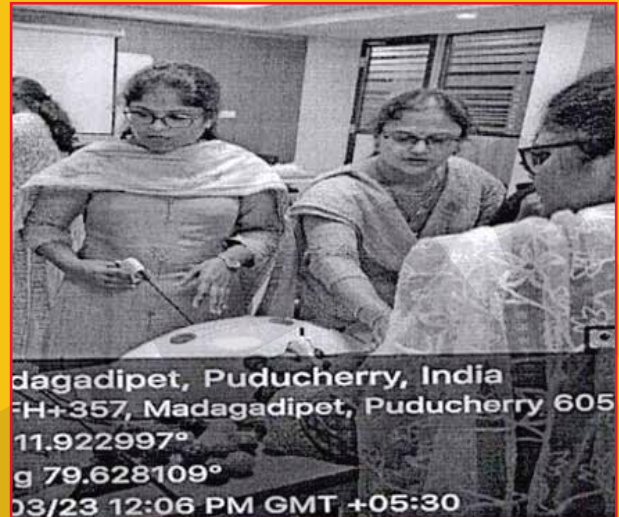
WORLD OBESITY DAY
