2.1 OPD at centre:

OPD runs every weekday from 8.30 am to 1 pm and then 2 pm to 8 pm. It receives laboratory support with basic investigations such as basic blood and urine examination, haemoglobin estimation, blood sugar, and serum cholesterol, blood urea etc. OPD is also supported by a counselling centre. It offers free treatment for minor ailments. The centre has a pharmacy attached to it. Patients who need referral are referred to our hospital or nearest government hospital at Villupuram. 2.2 Rural Mobile Clinic:

Among the most visible activities of RHTC, is 'Rural Mobile Clinic' (RMC) in the villages. During these clinics, Primary care for minor ailments is provided at village level. It is conducted from Tuesday to Friday (four days) during the morning hours on fixed days in the village. We have selected four villages within ten kilometre area. It is run by a team of medical interns, social worker and nursing staffs. No user fee is charged for the service. It provides an entry point for other health promotive and preventive activities in the village. It is an opportunity to build-up contact and faith among the villagers and to develop better understanding of the community among the staff of RHTC. It offers an opportunity to medical interns to educate patients in their social environment.

Objectives:

- 1. To ensure access to Primary health care to the villagers at their doorstep.
- 2. To ensure interaction of medical interns and postgraduate students with the local community.

2.3 Physiotherapy unit:



The unit consist of infra-red radiation, wax bath, short wave diathermy, inferential therapy, ultrasound stimulator, wood radar and marine wheel. 2.6 Internship Training Program:

We post our medical interns at RHTC for field exposure. Medical interns are given 'Internship card' to document their daily activities under the supervision of medical officers and Postgraduate in Community Medicine. Medical Interns have to work in centre OPD, Rural Mobile Clinic, participate in health education program and weekly academic program where we cover treatment guidelines and National Health Program. Interns' academic activities are held at RHTC on afternoon. They are given the topic of standard treatment guidelines of common conditions developed by the ministry of health and family welfare, India, which are relevant to their day to day practice. The discussion was facilitated by faculties and post graduate from the Community Medicine department.



b) Screening program for breast cancer and cervical cancer

Every Friday a team of assistant professor from Community Medicine and OBG, post graduates, interns, social workers and ANM conduct cancer screening program. The screening for breast and cervical cancer is done for the women above 30 years of age from the field practice area of RHTC. Breast cancer screening is done by physical examination and cervical cancer screening is done by Pap smear in collaboration with Department of Pathology. Along with the screening of breast and cervical cancer, women are also screened and treated for Sexually Transmitted Diseases. Partner treatment is also done with help of social workers. Also basic anthropometric measurements and blood examinations (Hb, blood glucose) are done for all the women. Totally 107 patients were screened last year. Out of that nilwere diagnosed to have carcinoma cervix and 1 were diagnosed to have pre invasive lesion.

a) School health education program

In order to promote health awareness among students, schools were identified in the villages of field practicing areas of RHTC. Every month on a particular topic fracture. R.N education and awareness was provided by a team of Assistant Professor, Healthan



Educator, Medical Social Worker, Post Graduate and Medical Interns in 4 Government schools namely 1) Government Elementary school - Kerimedu, 2) KGBV school - Andrayanallur, 3) KGBV school - Thiruvennainallur, 4) Government high school - Edaiyar, 5) Government high school - Periyasevallai. This activity helps generate awareness among students and in training medical interns.

Our centre functions as a Non-designated Microscopy centre. Our centre health inspector goes to the field and collects sputum samples from Tuberculosis suspects on a regular basis. Both active and passive surveillance for Tuberculosis is being done.

2.13 Community based Palliative care program

In order to utilise the trained manpower and resources, we planned to initiate community based palliative care services in the field practice areas (four villages) of our Rural Health Training Center. We have signed an MoU with Scope India for the providing support for community mobilisation activities and nursing care for people who need palliative care under the National Rural Health Mission.
