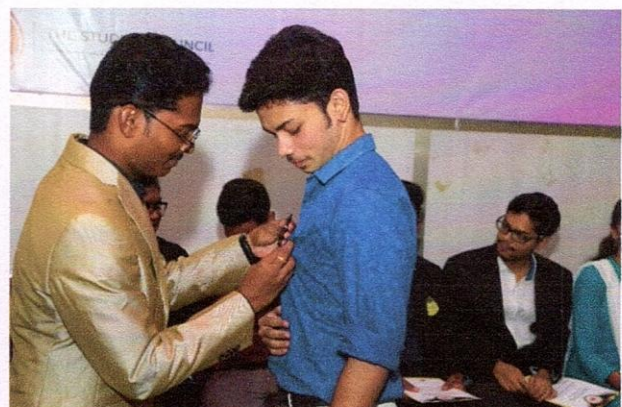
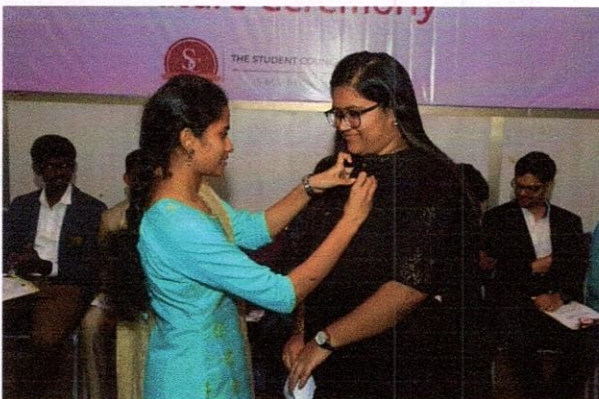

Our director, Dr. D. Rajagovindan, then distributed certificates to each member of the 5th Student Council body as a token of appreciation for their efforts over the past one year.

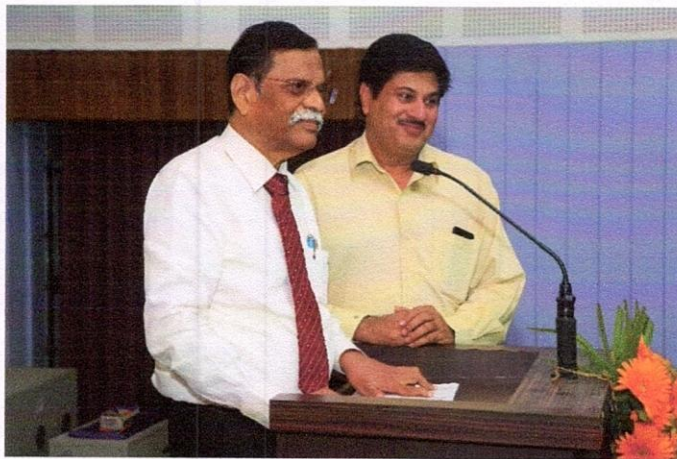


Next was the handing over ceremony where the old members of the council handed over their badges and to the newly appointed student council members forming the 6th governing body.

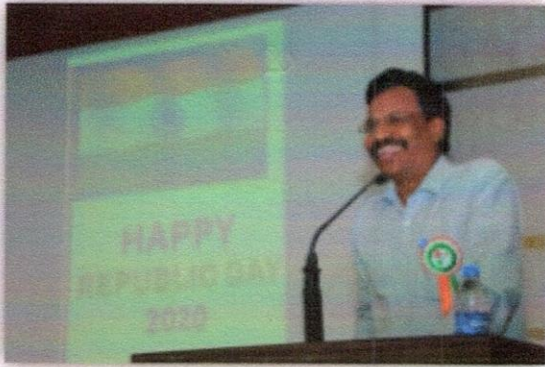

The Sports trophy and the Overall Sports trophy were awarded to Phoenix (2014 batch).

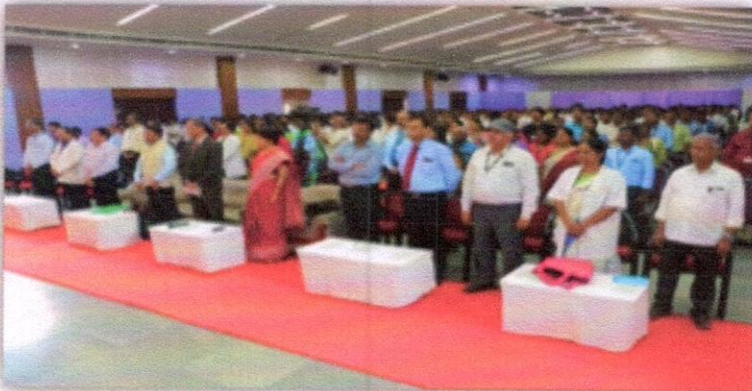
Galaxy'20 thus came to an end and like all years, this year was also made memorable, thanks to the active participation and enthusiasm of the staff and students.

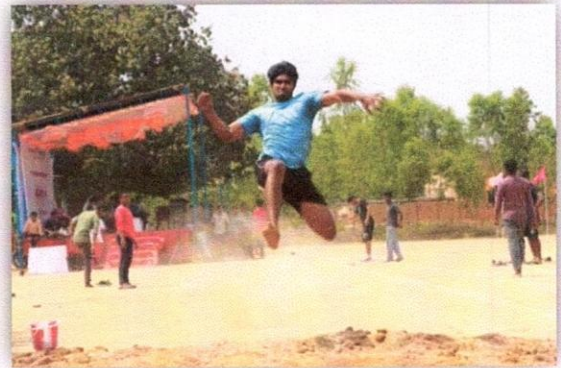

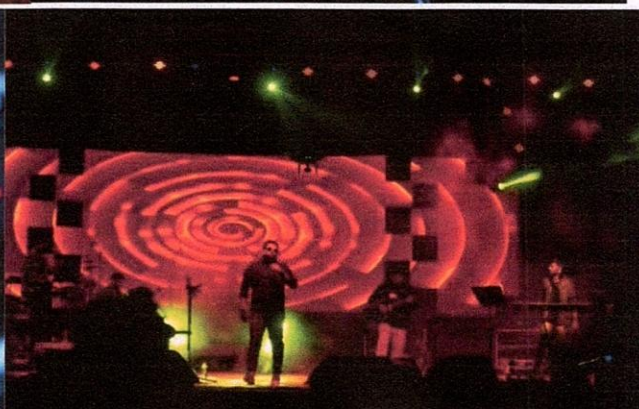
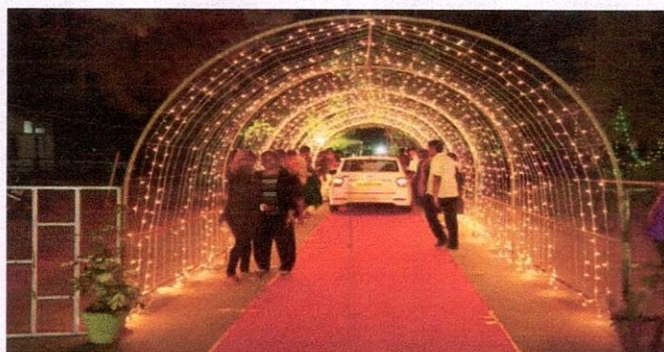




Pro Show:

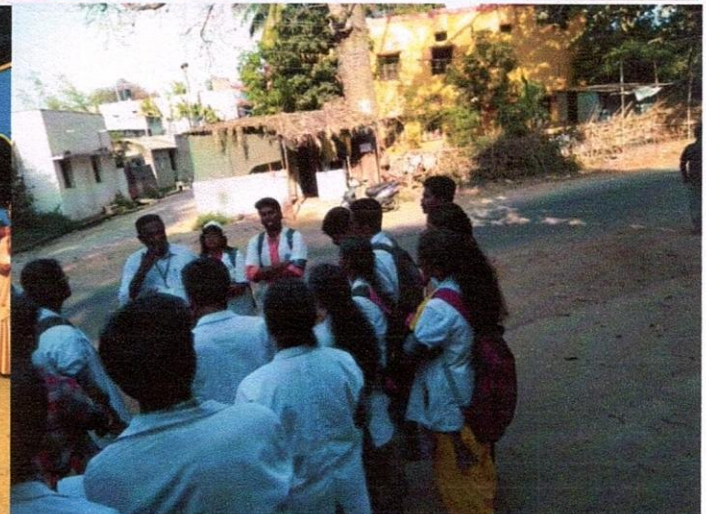
the glamorous look NEXUS'19 was released on March 7th 2019 during MANTRA by Mr.Sakthi.

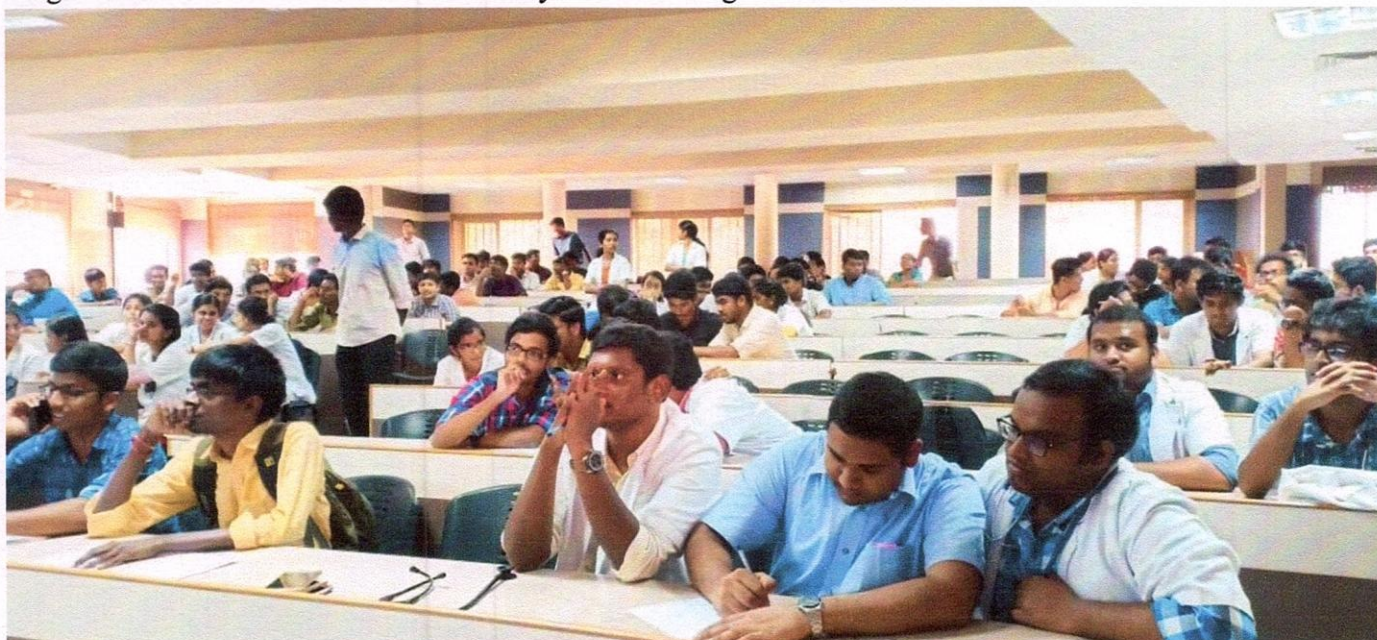
Participants: Students from the batch of 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017

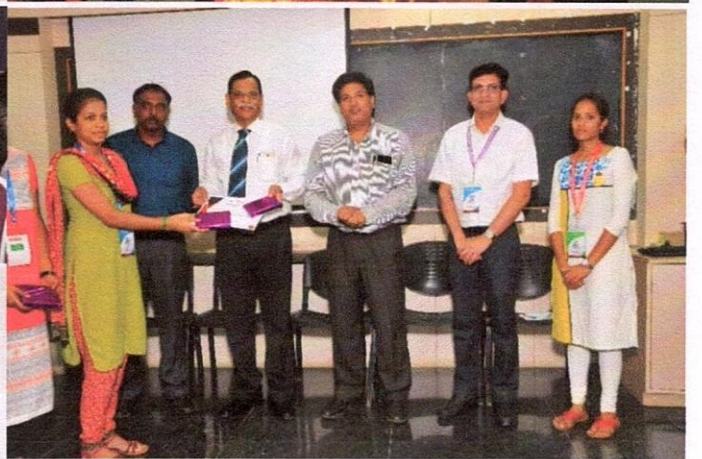
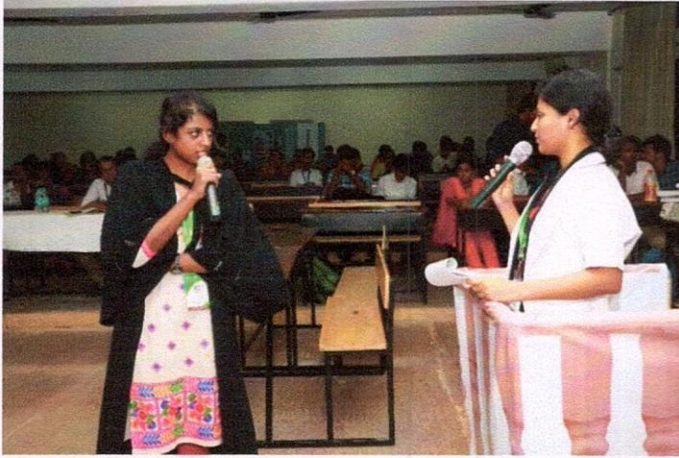

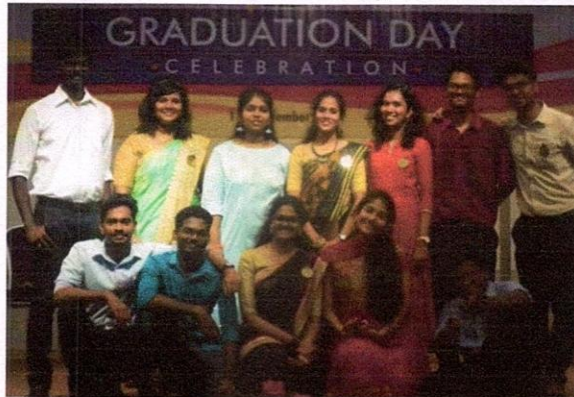




DOCERE'19

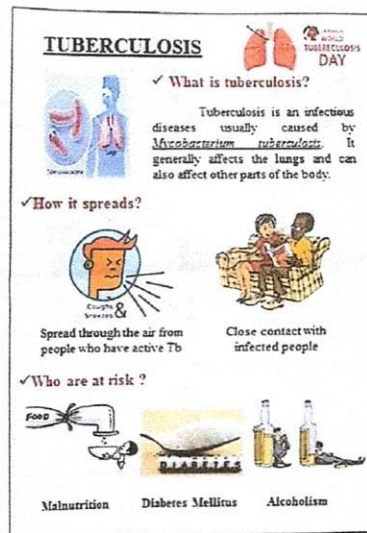
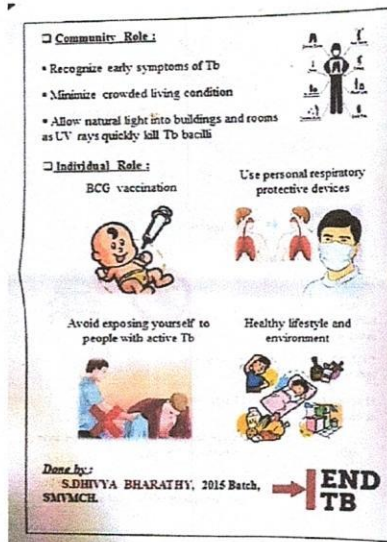


QUIZ CLUB

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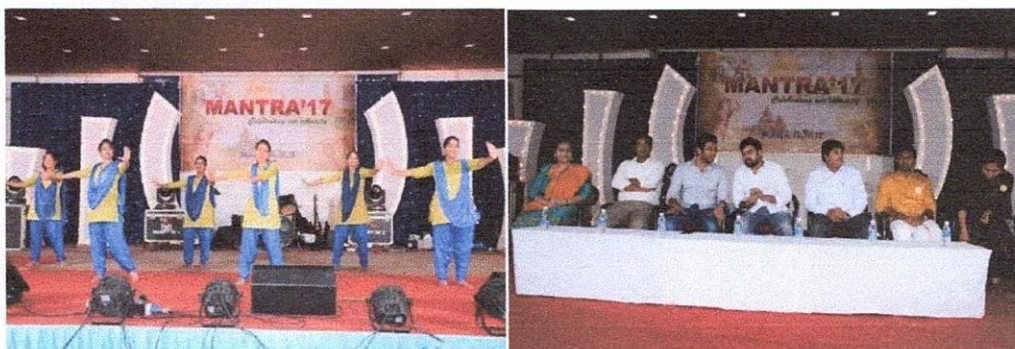

STUDENT COUNCIL 2017

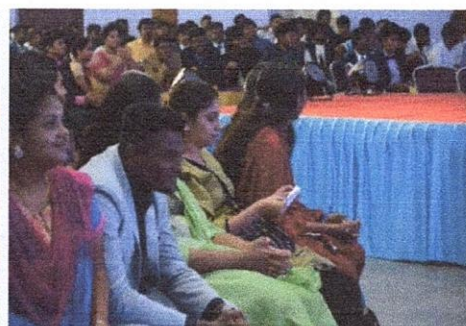

STUDENTS' PAIN & PALLIATIVE CARE PROGRAMME

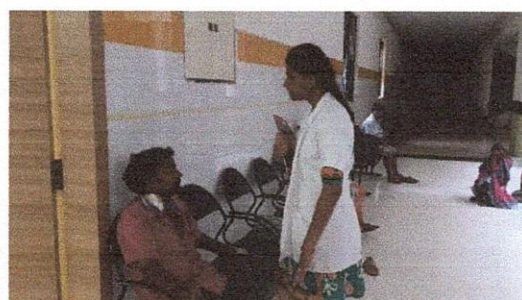
The programme was conducted in collaboration with the Department of Nephrology and Community Medicine. The programme was targeted towards the patients with chronic kidney disease on dialysis.

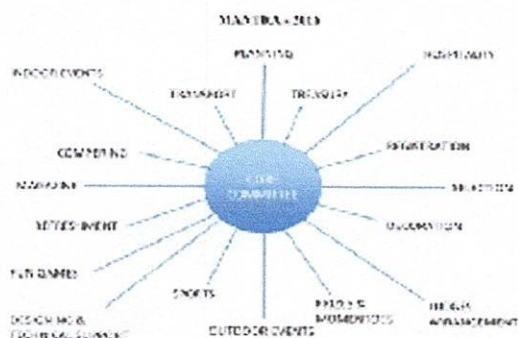
On speaking in the sidelines of the sports meet, Mr. Balaji stressed on the need to help people who are around us and not to bother about negative criticism

Around 375 students from all over the country participated in the workshops and enriched their knowledge. The day ended on a lighter note with a movie being projected at the auditorium.

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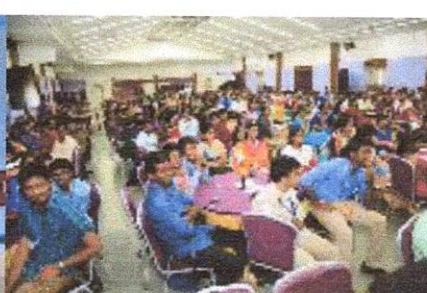
