Seminars were conducted on 'Stress Management' on 8th February 2022, 'Violence against Women' on March 21st 2022, and on Women Empowerment on April 4th 2022. A talk was organized on 'Women safety' on August 27, 2021 and on 'Women entrepreneurship skill, attitude & behavioural development' on December 24th, 2021. As per Pondicherry University norms we will conduct 8 internal assessment examinations and one Model examination during the academic year. We will take the average of the scores obtained in all 9 examinations and convert it for 40. The Minimum requirement to appear for the University examination is 50% Marks in internal assessment examination and 85% attendance in theory, practical and tutorials. Failing which the student will not be eligible to appear for the University examination. We will send the progress report periodically and I urge the parents to get involved in your children's education right from the beginning. We expect the parents to interact with the faculty as and when required to see that the minimum requirements of your wards are met with.

One of the goals of SMVMCH's educational program is to encourage independence and responsibility that are characteristic of a mature young adult. Since an orderly atmosphere is necessary for learning to take place, a discipline code that provides for the personal welfare of all the students, as well as for the common good of the entire college, is essential. As per Pondicherry University norms we will conduct 8 internal assessment examinations and one Model examination during the academic year. We will take the average of the scores obtained in all 9 examinations and convert it for 40. The Minimum requirement to appear for the University examination is 50% Marks in internal assessment examination and 85% attendance in theory, practical and tutorials. Failing which the student will not be eligible to appear for the University examination. We will send the progress report periodically and I urge the parents to get involved in your children's education right from the beginning.
