Station 1: Preparation at birth

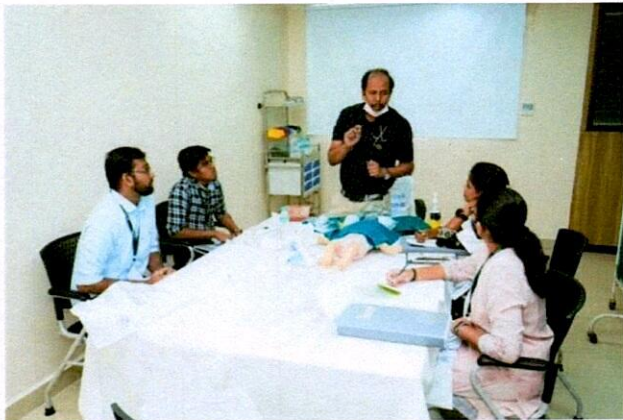
Station 2: Routine newborn care and initial steps of resuscitation

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The event was conducted successfully along with the distribution of participation certificate for each delegate.



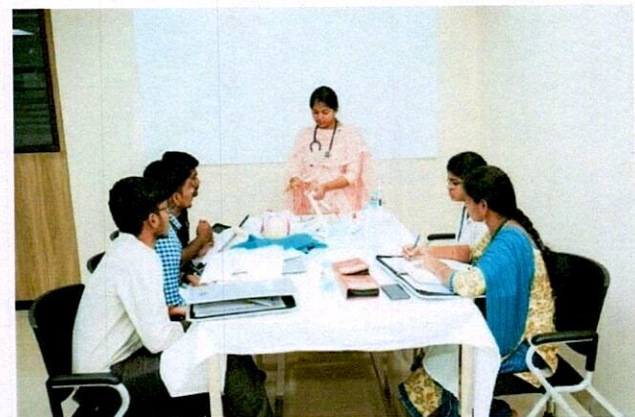
Preparation for the Birth



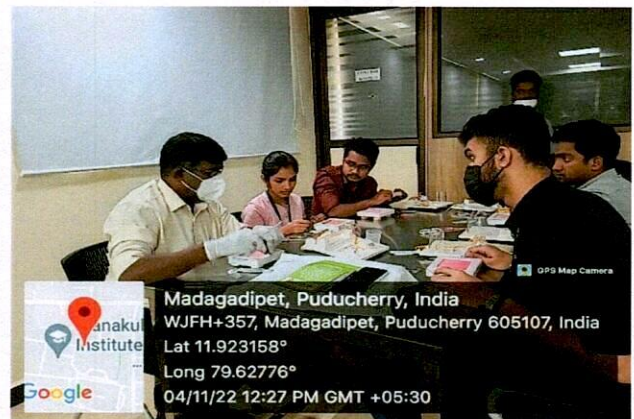

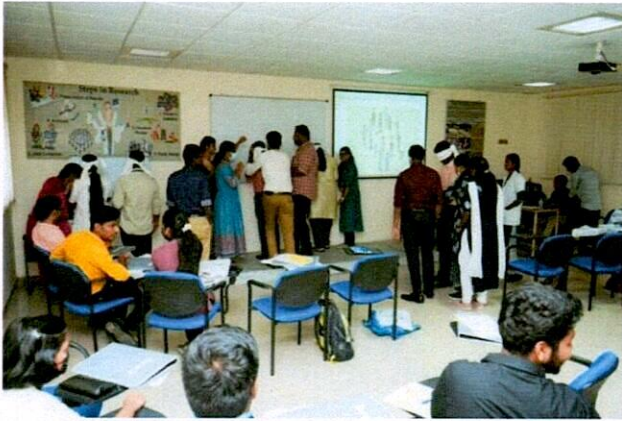
The afternoon session started at 02:15PM. There was a session on **skills for effective doctor - patient communication** and few group activities were conducted regarding the topic.

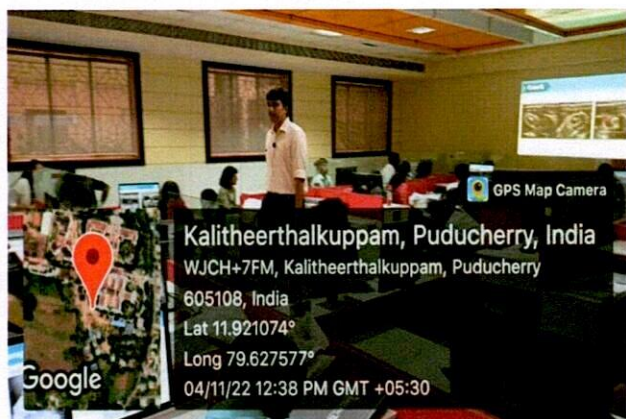

STUDENTS' PAIN & PALLIATIVE CARE PROGRAMME

The programme was conducted in collaboration with the Department of Nephrology and Community Medicine. The programme was targeted towards the patients with chronic kidney disease on dialysis.

Objective:

1. To counsel/communicate to the patients and their caregivers
2. To act as a intermediary between patient, caregiver and the clinical staff

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3. To improve basic knowledge regarding CKD condition, management, dialysis and other treatment options
4. To improve communication skills



Each visit spanned for about an hour after 4.30pm and volunteers were assigned as teams and each team visited the patients on a rotational basis. The students were put under mentors and were expected to report to them on a regular basis. All volunteers attended a training program by Dr. Suresh Kumar with Sanjeevan Pain & Palliative care.

QUIZ CLUB

Quiz classes were held for students from first year to final year every Wednesday in the evening. Questions were collected from Professors of various departments and the Secretary conducted the quiz. Questions were posted every day on the Student Council notice board and the students were encouraged to come up with answers which were discussed during the sessions. Sessions included lectures by experienced faculty. The club functioned throughout the year with several of its members winning several quiz competitions.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

The NSS organization of SMVMCH consisted of 1 unit in the year 2017, which held participation of 100 volunteers.

- NSS badges were released during the College day celebration of 2017.
- A 7 DAY CAMPAIGN was conducted involving all the NSS volunteers in the place Andayarpalayam from 20-03-2017 to 28-03-2017, which included field work of school cleaning, health screening for students at primary school and at Anganvadi, Health camp (on 28-03-17), Awareness programs regarding Tuberculosis, De-addiction, Menstrual Hygiene, Digital Banking.

The major highlight of the conference was the usage of QR codes. Each registrant who attended SIMSCON was assigned a unique QR code that was used for attendance, issue of food and other purposes, which made the conference technologically superior.

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1. CONFERENCE APP

This app is for all the delegates of a conference, which can be a single source of information and interaction at the conference. The intention is to **eliminate the paperwork** and help the delegates go through their day more effectively using the smart phone alone.

1.1 Basic App Functions

1. My Profile and **secure authentication** without having to remember any password
2. **Show and plan agenda**. The user will be able to select only one even per time slot to attend. Details of all events will be seen.
3. Get **reminders** to attend agenda items selected. Reminders can be sent when event coordinator marks live status of events that are about to start in each hall or automatically based on the time.
4. **Attachments** of PDF, Poster, PowerPoints, banners etc with optional voting competition for best entry (Workshop Material, Souvenir Book etc.)
5. Youtube links to Video clips in Agenda details and Attachments
6. Push notifications (On spot **Live Notifications**)
7. Google map integration to enable one touch travel to hotel
8. **Speaker profile** with photo, write up of their profile and social coordinates (FB, LinkedIn, Twitter and google plus). System will also show all the talks by that speaker in the profile
9. E-directory (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=cla43nuhrFs>)
10. Process of Registration becomes Simple. **Food Coupons** can be issued via a code in the app itself

1.2 Backend

The system will have web based dashboard that can be opened from any online PC with browser. Conference admins will be able to add most of the data elements from the backend. Lightweight landing page for SMS and email marketing and QR code to put on all banners and brochures for publicity

This system enables almost all functions with intermittent internet.

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2 EXPLANATION OF KEY FEATURES

2.1 Social Features

A delegate can give ratings to the talk/sessions which helps in getting overall review. He can give **his comment/post private questions to the speaker** who may choose to answer selected ones. This **increases audience participation** and enables speaker to know overall thought process. This feature will be available only to OTP authenticated members.

2.2 Speaker Scheduling System

App will have provision for entering the cell number and email of each speaker which is not visible to everyone. If the contact detail is provided, system will automatically send personalized SMS and email to the speaker giving detail, venue and time of their talk.

2.3 Secured Question Answer section

Organizers can **upload questions** and also specify the time for which the question will be active in case it is for a specific event. The apps will get the questions on next sync and they will be notified of the new question in the notification area as well. As this is a member only feature, non authenticated user will be prompted to enter his members profile and get authenticated. Organizers can start with scientific quiz, **feedback and opinions**. Only multiple choice questions will be allowed with no space to enter text.

Eventually secure Q&A section **can even be used for serious polls and elections** after everyone becomes comfortable with the usage.

Access Control

Every Quiz can have a customizable heading, start time and end time. Any number of multiple choice questions can be programmed to appear one after another in the quiz. Admin can also set the total amount of time permitted to answer the complete quiz which will be shown prominently.

A quiz can be tied to a session in the scientific agenda. If done so, it will also appear in the event detail screen as a button next to comments and ratings.

Reviewing and displaying Responses Speaker will be able to show **live bar graph of answer choices on the projector** if his laptop is connected. User will have an "Answered Questions" tab where aggregate responses will be show for only those quiz that they have attempted.
