### TRANSCRIPT

Hello everyone. This is Dr.P.Vijayasankar, Assistant Professor, Department of Dermatology, and Associate editor of Global Journal of Health Sciences and Research. In this podcast I will elucidate the editorial process of the Global Journal of Health Sciences and Research.

On behalf of our institution, we have launched our new In-house Journal named Global Journal of Health Sciences and Research on 20th February 2023. It is a peer-reviewed, completely open access, academic journal, currently published by the international publishing giant Scientific scholar. We published two issues of the journal in 2023, which received a robust response with articles across the globe from countries such as Bangladesh, Nigeria, Indonesia, and Sudan. We are happy to say that now we are receiving plenty of systematic reviews and meta-analysis.

At submission, the Editors check whether the topic of the article is suitable for the journal and screen the article using plagiarism checking software. If an article is deemed unfit for publication in our journal, an editorial rejection is made which allows the authors to submit the article elsewhere without undue delay. Once the Editor is satisfied that the writeup is original, it is assigned to 2-3 reviewers.

We have reviewer panel which includes eminent and qualified members of their scientific community willing to review articles for the journal. The reviewer reads and analyses the article to check whether the authors had a definite aim of the study, whether the methodology, data collection, sample size, and observations are appropriate, whether the findings were analysed appropriately, and whether the results and conclusions arrived at are justified.

Based on their impressions, the reviewers suggest revisions of the article unless it is found not worthy of publication. The editor, once receives the comments from all assigned

reviewers, will send the manuscript back to the author for revisions. The article is read through once again to see if the required corrections have been made, whether the author has replied to all the comments made by the reviewers, and whether the clarifications given are satisfactory. The editor then proceeds to edit the article for language and presentation, clarity of the text, figures, tables, their numbering and citing, references, consent statements, and acknowledgement. Only then, the article is sent to the publisher as accepted and ready for pagination.

In the future, we intend to continue improving the journal and reaching a wider audience; our long-term plan is to maintain our open access policy while focusing on publication of high-quality research. At the same time, we aim to further increase journal diversity in terms of content and authorship. Our vision is to get our journal indexed in the next few years and serve as a forum to publish multidisciplinary scientific content.
